In My Blood It Runs | Documentary

This documentary follows 10-yr-old Arrernte Aboriginal boy Djujan as he grows up Alice Springs, Australia. Djujan is a child-healer, a good hunter and speaks three languages



The Australian Dream | Documentary

The remarkable story of Indigenous AFL legend Adam Goodes. Through the backdrop of Goodes' journey, the feature documentary explores race, identity, and belonging in Australia today



This Place: Artist Series | Documentary

Six Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists from the National Gallery of Australia share their connection to Country, how it inspires their art and identity, and takes us to the places across Australia where their art making begins



Blue Water Empire | Documentary

A dramatised-documentary series giving a unique insight into the compelling history of the Torres Strait Islands, told through key stories by the men and women of the region



Lousy Little Sixpence | Video

Lousy Little Sixpence (1983) is a short 4 part documentary highlighting the injustice of withheld wages, and the fight for rightful payment to be made to Indigenous peoples

3KND - Kool 'N' Deadly | Radio

Melbourne's first Indigenous owned and managed AM radio station hit the airwaves in June 2003 and is proudly Melbourne's only Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander radio station. It is independent, not-for-profit, and on the airwaves 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.



Tiddas 4 Tiddas | Podcast

Tiddas 4 Tiddas is a podcast featuring candid conversations with Kamilaroi/Dunghutti sisters, Marlee and Keely Silva. This story sharing network showcases successful Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women role models and their stories, and circulates advice and academic, sporting and other opportunities for young Indigenous women to reach their full potential.



Indigipreneur | Podcast

This podcast inspires and promotes positive change within Indigenous communities, helps motivate people to achieve their dreams, and brings you stories from the doers and thinkers.



Speaking Out | Podcast

Politics, arts and culture from a range of Indigenous perspectives. Speaking Out broadcasts on Radio National on Fridays at 8pm (repeated Tuesdays 2am) and on ABC Local Radio on Sundays at 9pm.

Massacre Map
This map shows the locations of known killings of Aboriginal peoples by Europeans for the 18 years between 1836 and 1853



Stolen Generations' Testimonies
This is an initiative to record on film the personal testimonies of Australia's Stolen Generations Survivors and share them online



Stolen Generations Report
This report, collated by the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare (AIHW), provides contemporary evidence of the 'gap within the gap'.
